A private, member-only organization

SAFETY, FIRE, EMERGENCY & GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- **Muster Station -**
 - In case of a safety emergency or man overboard, go to the main level aft (rear) deck by ladder to the marina, in between the shark and the white crane.
 - Grab hold of the white railing and wait to be counted before leaving
- **Man Overboard -**
 - If you see someone overboard, keep your eye on the person and yell for help.
 - You must watch AND POINT to the person and consistently yell, "MAN OVERBOARD"
 - Do not take your eyes off of the person in the water!
 - Send someone else for a life buoy/ring and for help. Notify RESORT personnel immediately
- **Life Vests -**
 - There are 4 life vests located in each room in the closets
- **Life Buoys -**
 - 4 life buoys are located on each deck along the railings, 2 on each side
 - 2 life buoys are located in the marina area
 - To use, hold the black strap on the rope bag and toss the ring into the water OVER the victim's head. Pull the buoy back to the victim. If there is no rope bag, simply throw the ring to the victim. Do NOT throw the buoy at the victim's head!
- **Life Rings -**
 - There are two 25-person life rings on board
 - One is on the main deck aft (rear) near the rails One is on the heli-deck
- **Life Rafts -**
 - There are two 50-person inflatable life rafts on board
 - They are located on the 2nd deck, aft (rear) area
- **Marina Area -**
 - For safety reasons, members are not allowed down in the marina area unless escorted by RESORT personnel
- **Black out scenario -**
 - If you are on the crew level or below- **stand or sit still** and repeat your name loudly. We will come to you.
 - If you are above the crew deck, or can find your way, go to the muster station for a head count. We will count everyone and then sweep the vessel to find everyone.
- **Fire -**
 - If you see a fire, immediately move to the muster station and notify RESORT personnel.
 - Fire extinguishers are located throughout the vessel. Please note where they are.
 - The fire system can be activated by pulling the red-box alarms located on the walls throughout the vessel.
- **Fire & Safety Plan Map -**
 - Located on the wall at the entrance to the reception area.
 - This plan shows the locations of life rings, life bouys, rafts and fire extinguishers.
- **Smoking -**
 - There is absolutely **NO** smoking indoors anywhere on board the vessel!
 - Due to wind and threat of blowing ashes, smoking is only allowed at the **REAR** of the main deck and second deck **OUTSIDE.**
 - Make sure to control where your cigarette butts go. When you use a trash can, make sure the butt is wet first.
- **Accidents or Injuries -**
 - Please report all accidents or injuries to RESORT personnel immediately
- **Sign In Sheet -**
 - You must sign in when you arrive on Fisherman's Paradise and again prior to departure from Fisherman's Paradise
- **Off Limit Areas -** (We can escort you to any of these if you wish to see them)
 - Beyond the pool area on the main deck.
 - Crew deck and machinery deck (with the exception of the lower gym)
 - Heli-Deck (unless arriving and departing by helicopter)
- **Toilets -**
 - Please only flush toilet tissue down the toilets. Our sewage processing plant cannot handle non-dissolvable waste items.
- **Laundry -**
 - In order to save water and energy, Member linens will be turned over after the second night on board, unless otherwise specified or requested.
- **Alcohol -**
 - Be very careful as it is easy to forget you are on a ship and there are many areas to fall overboard
 - Misuse of alcohol will get you banned from the RESORT permanently
- **Drugs, Narcotics Non-Prescription Medication -**
 - We have a **ZERO-TOLERANCE** policy on board Fisherman's Paradise. Any Member caught violating this policy will be immediately detained or removed from Fisherman's Paradise and reported to the authorities.
- **Paperwork -** You must provide us with a copy of your passport and current contact information
- **Food Times -** Breakfast 7:00 - 9:00 AM, Lunch 11AM - 1PM, Dinner 7:00- 9:00 PM
